Submit two copies of the MOSIS customer agreement with the original signature of an authorized person on each one. If your university already has an account with MOSIS, the customer agreement for that existing account will cover new accounts, therefore a new agreement is not necessary. 		

3. MOSIS Individual Academic Non Disclosure Agreement for professor. Submit a copy signed by the professor.
4. List of students or staff members who have signed the MOSIS Individual Academic Non Disclosure Agreement.
5. Background and qualifications of professor.

NOTE: If you wish to have access to vendor design rules, process specifications, and other proprietary vendor documents, you will need to include in your application package an Application for Access to Vendor Proprietary Documents and signed copies of the appropriate special agreements. Note that the MOSIS Customer Agreement includes the following section on the protection of proprietary information.

EACH PARTY SPECIFICALLY AGREES THAT IT SHALL NOT DISCLOSE ANY MATERIAL WHICH MAY BE CONSIDERED PROPRIETARY OR CONFIDENTIAL MATERIAL OF THE OTHER PARTY OR OF ANY VENDORS TO ANY THIRD PARTIES. PROPRIETARY MATERIAL SHALL INCLUDE BUT SHALL NOT BE LIMITED TO, PROPRIETARY VENDOR INFORMATION SUCH AS YIELD AND PARAMETRIC DATA, WHETHER IT WAS PROVIDED TO CUSTOMERS OR EXTRACTED BY THEM. EACH PARTY AGREES THAT IT SHALL BE PRECLUDED BY 19 U.S.C. 1905 AND ANY AND ALL OTHER APPROPRIATE LAWS AND REGULATIONS FROM KNOWINGLY DIVULGING THE TRADE SECRETS OF THE OTHER PARTY, AND/OR ANY THIRD-PARTY VENDOR.

Violation of this agreement will result in IMMEDIATE REVOCATION of the associated accounts and IMMEDIATE DISQUALIFICATION of the responsible parties from further participation in the MOSIS Education Program.
